Today we remember the birth of a new community, the Church. This is the day the apostles left the upper room, where they were hiding and began to preach publicly about Jesus and his message. They could not have done this without the 'power from on high.'

First Reading: (Acts. 2:1-11)

Luke describes the descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles, and the effect it had on them.

Second Reading: (1 Cor. 12:3-7;12-13)

The Holy Spirit gives different gifts to different people, for the good of the Church, the Body of Christ.

Gospel: John 20:19-123)

The risen Jesus gives the gift of the Holy Spirit to his disciples and begins the mission of the Church.
