❖ Trinity Sunday

We begin and end the celebration of the Eucharist with the names of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is a mystery to be celebrated with trust and love. Coming together for the Eucharist should deepen our relationship with the Blessed Trinity.

Gospel: (Mt. 28:16-20)

In his last appearance to the apostles, Jesus commissions them to preach the gospel to all people, and promises to be with them until the end of time.
