In the gospel we have Peter's profession of faith. In response to that confession, Jesus makes a threefold disclosure: that Messiah must suffer; that his disciples must be prepared to share his suffering; and that his and their suffering will lead to ultimate glory.

First Reading: (Isaiah: 50:5-9)

The just person is sustained in all his trials by the firm belief that God is with him.

Second Reading: (James: 2:14-18)

Faith without good works is dead.

Gospel: (Mark 8:27-35)

Even though Peter declares his belief in Jesus as Messiah, he has no idea what that implies.
