In biblical times widows were among the poorest of the poor. In the gospel the true piety of the widow contrasts sharply with the false piety of the Scribes. The widow let go of every shred of security and committed herself totally to God. Her generosity comes from her trust in God.

First Reading: (1 Kings 17:10-16)

In the middle of a famine, a poor widow shares the last of her food, with the prophet Elijah, and far from losing by doing so, she is enriched.

Second Reading: (Heb. 9:24-28)

Through his death Christ has taken our sins upon himself and has opened for us the door to salvation.

Gospel: (Mark 12:38-44)

In the eyes of others the offering of the widow was the least, but in the eyes of Christ, it was the greatest.
