John the Baptist said to his contemporaries: "There stands among you one whom you know not." He was referring to Jesus, who was present among his people, even though he wasn't noticed. Jesus is present among us as we gather to celebrate this Eucharist.

First Reading: (Is. 61: 1-2; 10-11)

The writer declares that he has been sent by god to usher in the age of salvation. Jesus used this prophecy to announce the programme of his own ministry.

Second Reading: (1 Thess. 5:16-24)

St. Paul tells the Thessalonians how they ought to live as they await the second coming of Christ.

Gospel: (John 1:6-8; 19-28)

John the Baptist declares that he is not the Saviour. His task is to prepare the way for the Saviour, who is already among the people, though they do not recognize him.
