Second Reading: (Col. 3:1-4)

Gospel: (John 20:1-9)

On discovering that Jesus' tomb is empty, the disciples begin to grasp what the Scriptures had foretold, namely that He would rise from the dead.

Or persecuted for professing the name of their redeemer,


They all give him what he needs.
