FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT 6TH MARCH 2022

Last Wednesday we began the season of Lent. It is an opportunity for us to examine our commitment to Christ and his Word. Lent is a time for us to turn away from sin and believe in the gospel.

First Reading: (Deut. 26:4-10)

REFLECTION

There is no point in planting a seed if the ground is frozen.
