#### SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - 28th July 2024

CHRIST FED THE HUNGRY AND DID SO WITH GREAT GENEROSITY. HERE HE FEEDS US WITH THE BREAD OF THE EUCHARIST. WE RECEIVE THIS PRECIOUS FOOD NOT BECAUSE WE DESERVE IT BUT BECAUSE WE NEED IT.

**First Reading**: (2Kings 4:42-44): The miracle described shows God's concern for his people during a period of famine.

**Second Reading**: (Eph. 4:1-6): Here Paul pleads with the Ephesians to live a life worthy of the gospel.

**Gospel**: (John 6:1-15): Like Elisha, Jesus the prophet of the new covenant feeds the hungry people.

**REFLECTION:** All day from that deep well of life within Himself has he drawn healing from the press of folk, restoring strength, forgiving sin, quieting frenzy, comforting distress. Shadows of evening fall, yet wildly still they throng him, touch him, touch his garment's hem, fall down and clasp his feet, cry on him, till the Master, spent, slips from the midst of them and climbs the mountain for a cup of peace. Taking a sheer and rugged track untrod save by a poor lost sheep with a thorn-torn fleece that follows on and hears him talk with God.
