EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - 4th AUGUST 2024

In last Sunday's gospel we heard that Jesus fed the people in the desert. When they came back to be fed the following day he said to them; "Do not work for perishable food; work for the food that endures to eternal life"

First Reading: (Ex. 16:2-4): The people of Israel complained that they were brought out to the desert to suffer. To alleviate their hunger Jesus provided them with manna.

Second Reading: (Eph. 4:17.20-24): Paul has reminded his Gentile readers that they have become coheirs with Jesus.

Gospel: (John 6:24-35): Jesus reminds the people that he did not come to feed them with bread. He came to strengthen faith.

REFLECTION

God provided mysterious food called manna for the Israelites during their sojourn in the desert. However they were told not to stockpile the manna but to gather only what was needed for one day. This was meant to teach them to trust in God's providence on a daily basis no matter how difficult life can be. For those who trust in God and live a day at a time the manna of his help falls every day.
