We are here to worship God. Jesus said of the Pharisees: this people honour me with their lips; but their hearts are far from me.

It is only with our hearts that we can truly worship God.

<u>First Reading</u>: (Deut. 4:1-2.6-8): These words are from Moses before the chosen people enters the Promised Land. He asks them to be faithful to God's Law.

Second Reading: (James 1:17-18): This reading shows us the link between faith and love. Genuine religion expresses itself in the service of those in need.

<u>Gospel</u>: (Mark 7:1-8): Jesus told the Pharisees that they have substituted their own law for the Law of God.

<u>Reflection</u>

Today pollution is a big issue and rightly so. People want clean water, clean air and so on. But the most dangerous pollution of all is evil. So what must we do? We must purify the source. The heart is the source. It is the wellspring from which all our thoughts, words and deeds flow. Lord, cleanse our hearts with your grace so that all our thoughts, words and deeds may be like water flowing from a pure spring.




