TWENTY THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 8th SEPTEMBER 2024

Jesus makes the deaf hear and the dumb speak. Let us turn to the Lord and ask him to touch our ears so that we may hear and to touch our tongues so that we can profess our faith.

First Reading: (Is. 35.4-7) This is a message of hope for God's people while in exile. The prophet assures the people that God will come to their help. **Second Reading**: (James 2:1-5): This passage is concerned with class distinction; deploring a favouring of the rich and looking down on the poor. **Gospel**: (Mk. 7:31-37): This is the curing of the deaf man who has a speech impediment.

REFLECTION

The gift of hearing is a priceless gift, but it is only the heart that can hear rightly. The cry of a needy person may reach our ears, but unless it reaches our heart, we will not feel a person's pain.

And it is unlikely that we will respond.

And the gift of speech is a priceless gift,
but again it is only with the heart that we can speak rightly.

For our words to ring true; they must come from the heart.

If they only come from the lips, they will have a hollow sound and will have little effect. They will be like a sound that ruffles the surface of the water, but leaves the depths untouched.

PRAYERS/INTENTIONS - A basket will be left at the altar for people to place their intentions/prayer requests.


