TWENTY FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 22nd SEPTEMBER 2024

In the gospel there is a prediction of the Passion which the disciples don't understand. Instead they are motivated by selfish ambition — they get involved in an argument as to which of them is the greatest. This kind of selfishness is condemned by Jesus and by James (in the second reading).

<u>First Reading</u>: (Wis. 2:12.17-20) The godless plot to do away with the just one, because his blameless life is a reproach to them.

<u>Second Reading</u>: (James 3:16-4:3): Jealousy, ambition and self-seeking lead to disharmony. Gentleness and mercy lead to peace.

<u>Gospel</u>: (Mark 9:30-37): Jesus tells his apostles that he will suffer humiliation and death. True greatness is shown in serving the weaker members of the community.


