TWENTY EIGHT SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 13th OCTOBER 2024

In the gospel we read how riches kept a young man from following Christ. We are disciples of Christ. But we don't always follow Christ as closely as we should. Let us think for a moment what keeps us from following Christ.

First Reading: (Wis. 7.7-11): This passage is presented as a speech of Solomon in honour of the gift of wisdom. Wisdom teaches us how to live rightly.

Second Reading: (Heb. 4.12-13) This word extends and explains the thoughts of the hearts. The authority of this word comes from God.

Gospel: (Mk. 10:17-30): This is a discipleship story. Love of personal possessions keeps us from God's love.

Jesus invited the young man to follow him, But riches got in the way.

Even though Jesus was sad to see him go, There is no point in forcing young people to make sacrifices. If you can take things from people, they are impoverished, But if you can get them to give them up, they are enriched. People are essentially good. But this goodness has to be awakened and called forth if they enter the kingdom of love.
