#### FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 6th July 2025

<u>First Reading</u>: (Is. 66:10-14): Written after the return from the Babylon exile, this poem paints a glowing picture of the blessings God will bestow on Jerusalem and its inhabitants. <u>Second Reading</u>: (Ga. 6:14-18): Paul insists that the Christian life means becoming like Christ. He himself bears the marks of suffering on his body. <u>Gospel</u>: (Lk. 10:1-12, 17-20): This tells us of the sending out of the seventy two disciples.
