❖ **Baptism of the Lord**

**Second Reading:** (Titus 2:11-14; 3:4-7)

God's grace and love are manifested in Jesus Christ.

**Gospel:** (Luke: 3:15-16; 21-22)

We have a small example of the preaching of John the Baptism and a brief account of the baptism of Jesus.
